Who Is Part of the IEP Team?


- Parent
- Student, if appropriate
- General Education Teacher
- Special Education Teacher
- At least one child study team member
- Case manager
- Therapists (PT, OT, Speech), if applicable
- School district representative, if applicable
- Others at the discretion of the parent or school district

Eligibility Criteria:

-Determined by CST based upon NJ Administrative Code

- Auditory Impairment
- Autism
- Intellectual Disability
- Communication
 Impairment
- Emotional Regulation
 Impairment
- Multiple Disabilities
- Deaf/Blindness

- Other Health Impairment
- Preschool Child with a disability
- Social Maladjustment
- Specific Learning Disability
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Visual Impairment
- Orthopedic Impairment

Progress reporting

Participation in general education settings

Plans to address your child's behavioral, health, and/or transition needs

Annual IEP Review Meeting


- Come prepared with questions.
