- The Tenakill Science Olympiad Team, under the guidance of Ms. Moidu and Mr. Hernandez, qualified to participate in the state regional competition and placed fourth overall in New Jersey! Students competed in various individual events and placed in the top five teams for ten of the twenty-one events offered.
- Avinash Sabnani, grade 8, was honored as one of the brightest students in the world by Johns Hopkins University Center for Talented Youth. Avinash was one of over 15,300 students from 76 countries who participated in the 2021-2022 Talent Search. He received grand honors, the highest award, for his placement on the SAT, which is typically taken in high school, but Avinash tested in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. He placed 97% in overall SAT scored nationally. He was presented with the grand honors medal on February 14, 2023.
