Grades 1 and 2 teachers will post assignments via Seesaw. Grade 3 teachers will post via Google Classroom. Grade 4 teachers will post via Schoology. ● Special content area teachers (art, music, physical education, etc.) will post a minimum of one assignment or activity per week. ● Teachers will answer questions via school email or Schoology between 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. ● Teachers will be available online for two hours each weekday to provide real time assistance to students and parents, either through email or online availability. Teachers must post the online availability. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will register their attendance for the virtual school day by 10:00 a.m. via: https://hillside.closterschools.org/ ● Students may access assigned learning each weekday by 9:00 a.m. ● Students will complete the assigned learning. ● Students will return assignments to teachers by due date, via email or through Seesaw, Google Classroom or Schoology. The teacher will indicate how to submit the assignment. <p><i>*Parents/care providers may reach out to teachers via school email or Schoology to ask questions or get feedback on assignments.</i></p>	<p>Is technology required for our Virtual Learning days? <i>Teachers will be posting student assignments and expectations for the virtual day learning through email, Seesaw, Google Classroom, or Schoology; however, if a student has indicated they do not have an Internet-connected device at their residence, devices will be provided.</i></p> <p>How will students be expected to “make up” their learning if not in attendance? <i>Students will be responsible for doing the required daily work on their own time as they would in any other situation in which they may have been absent from school.</i></p>
