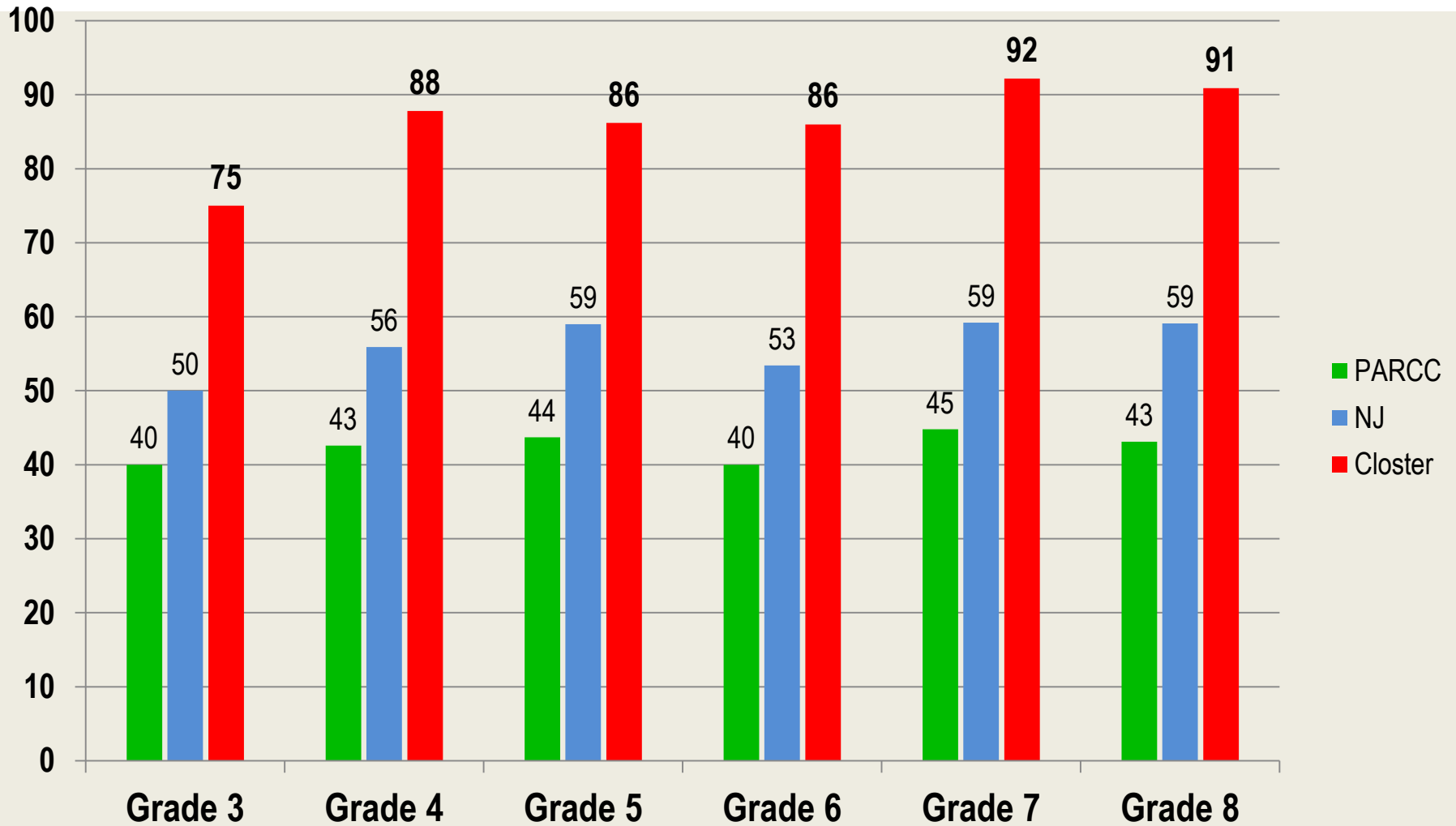

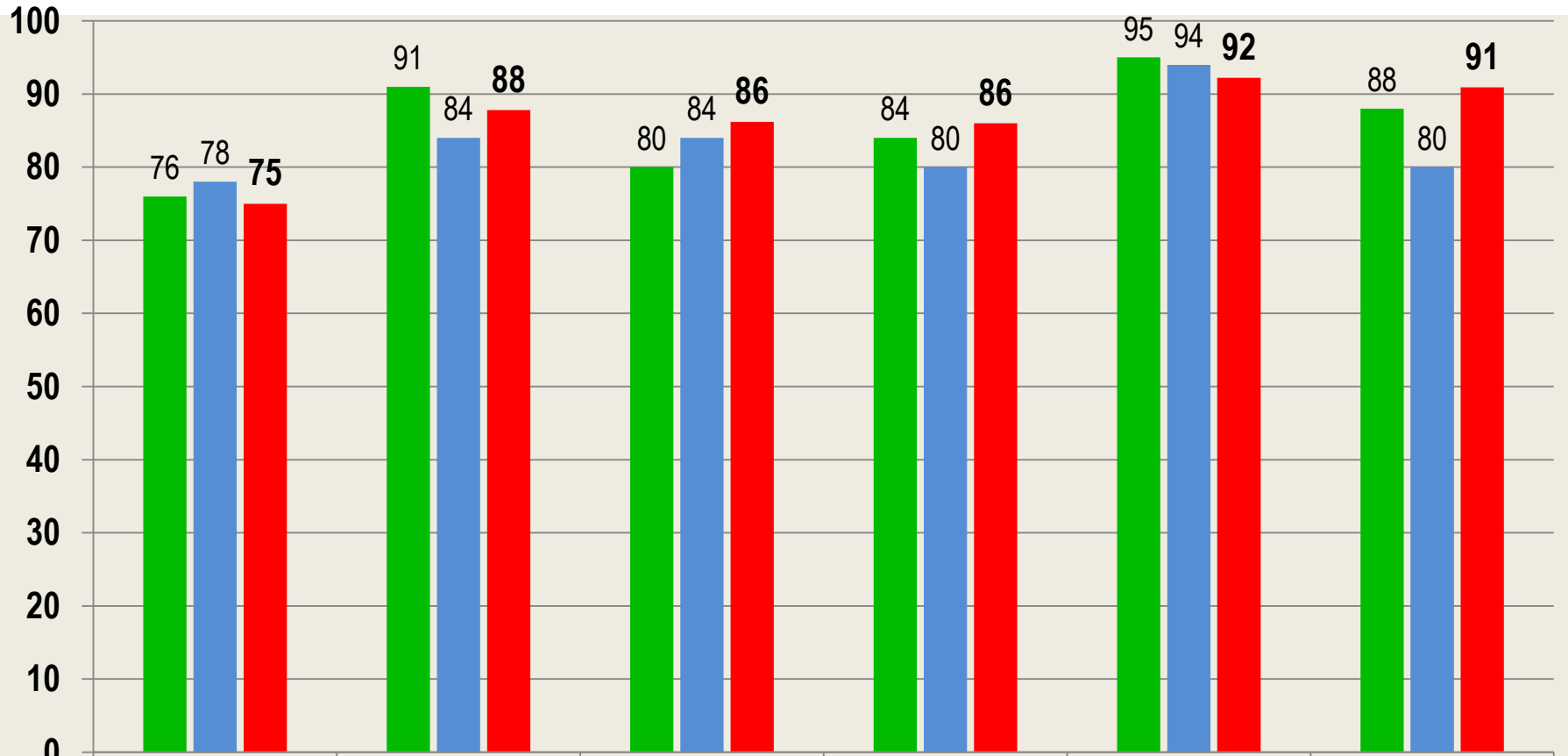

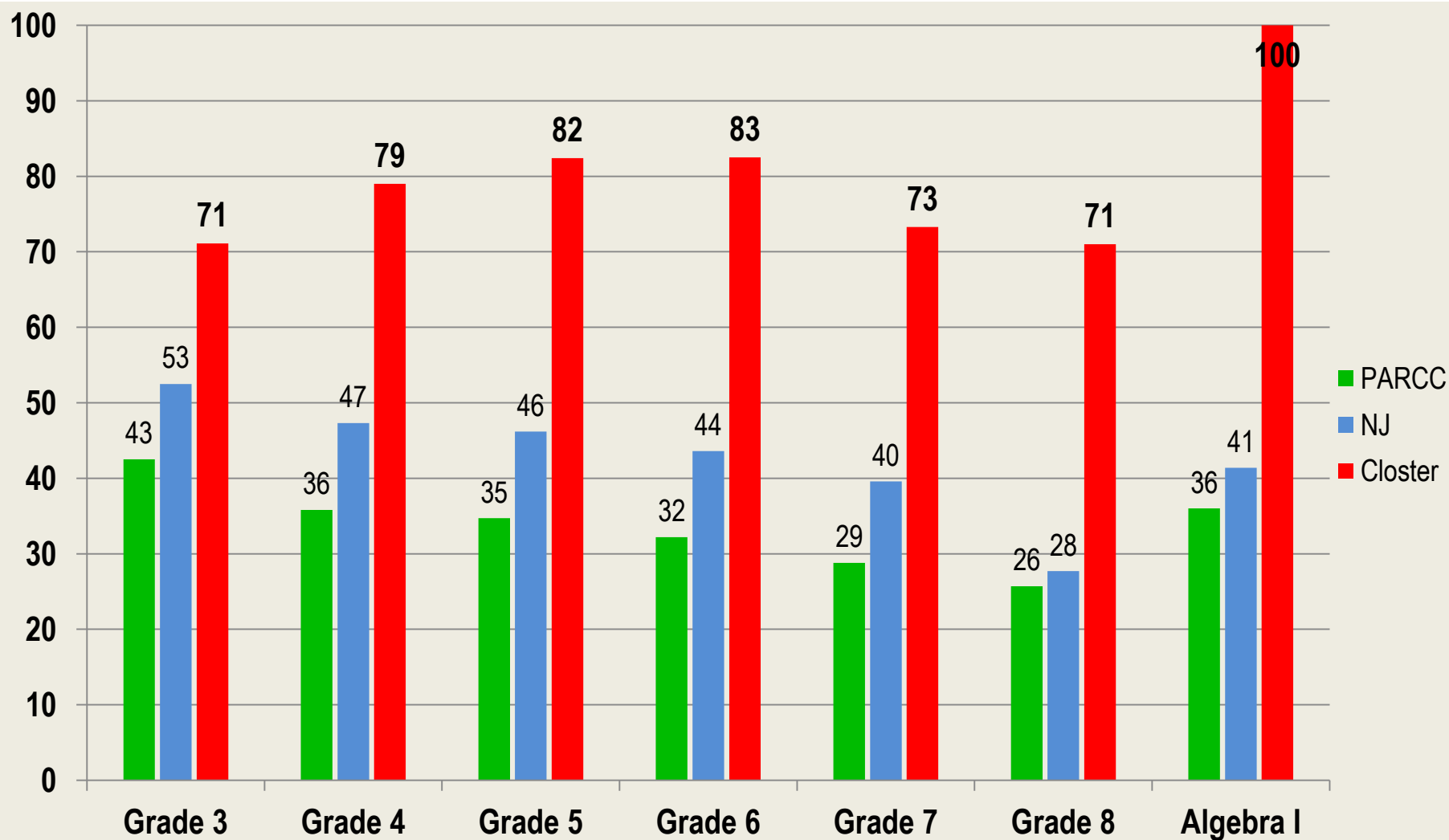

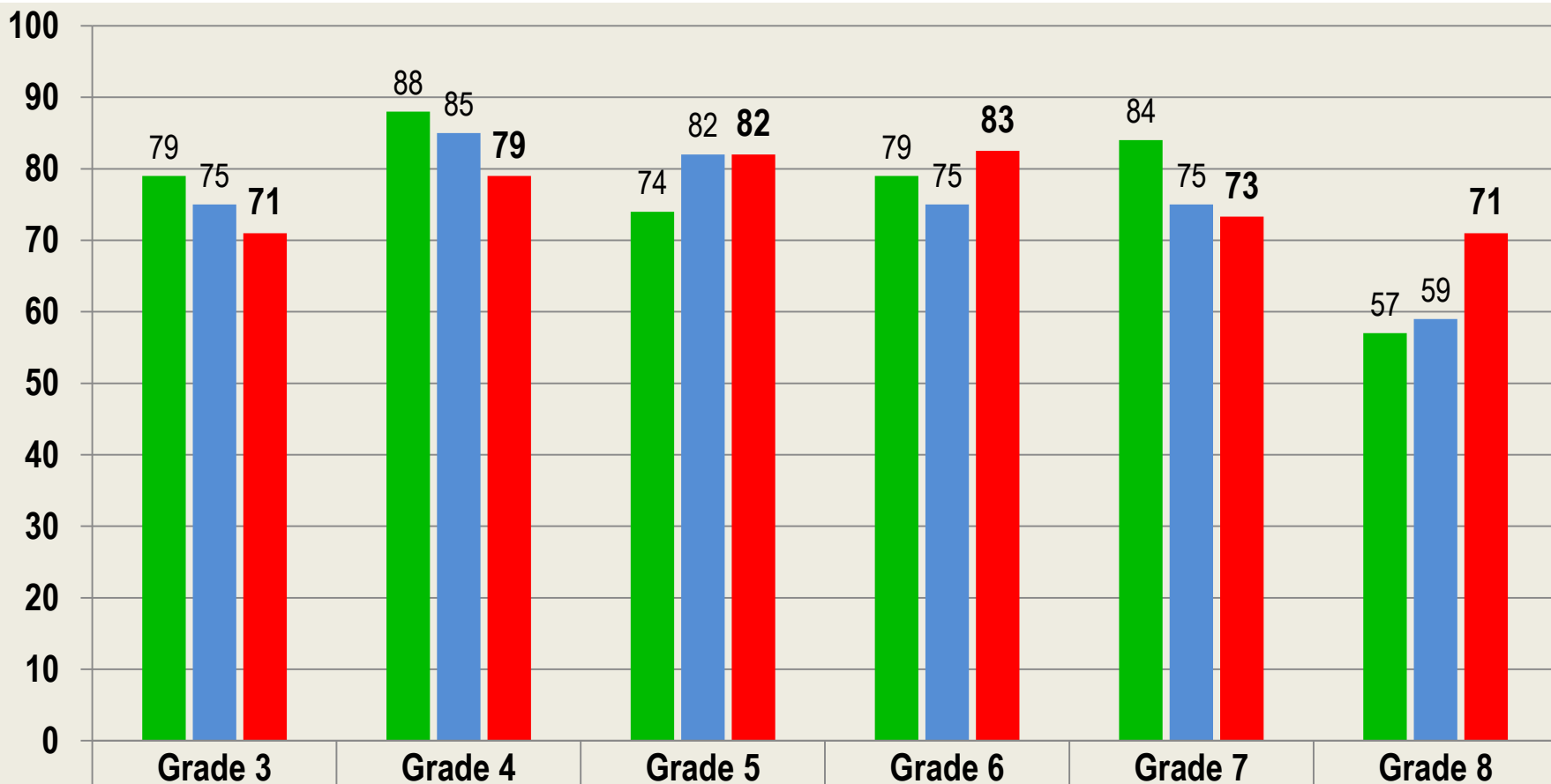

MATHEMATICS - PERCENTAGES

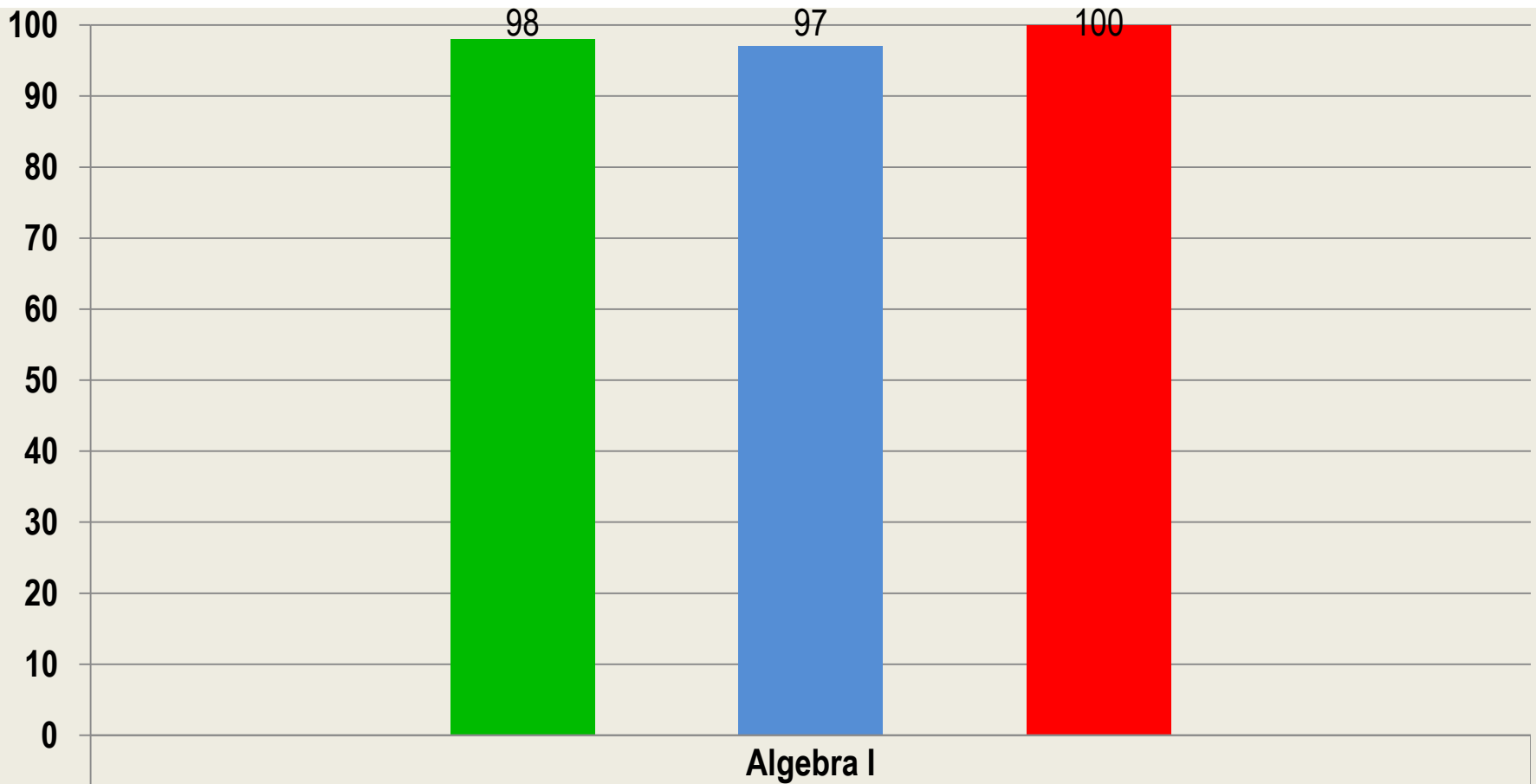

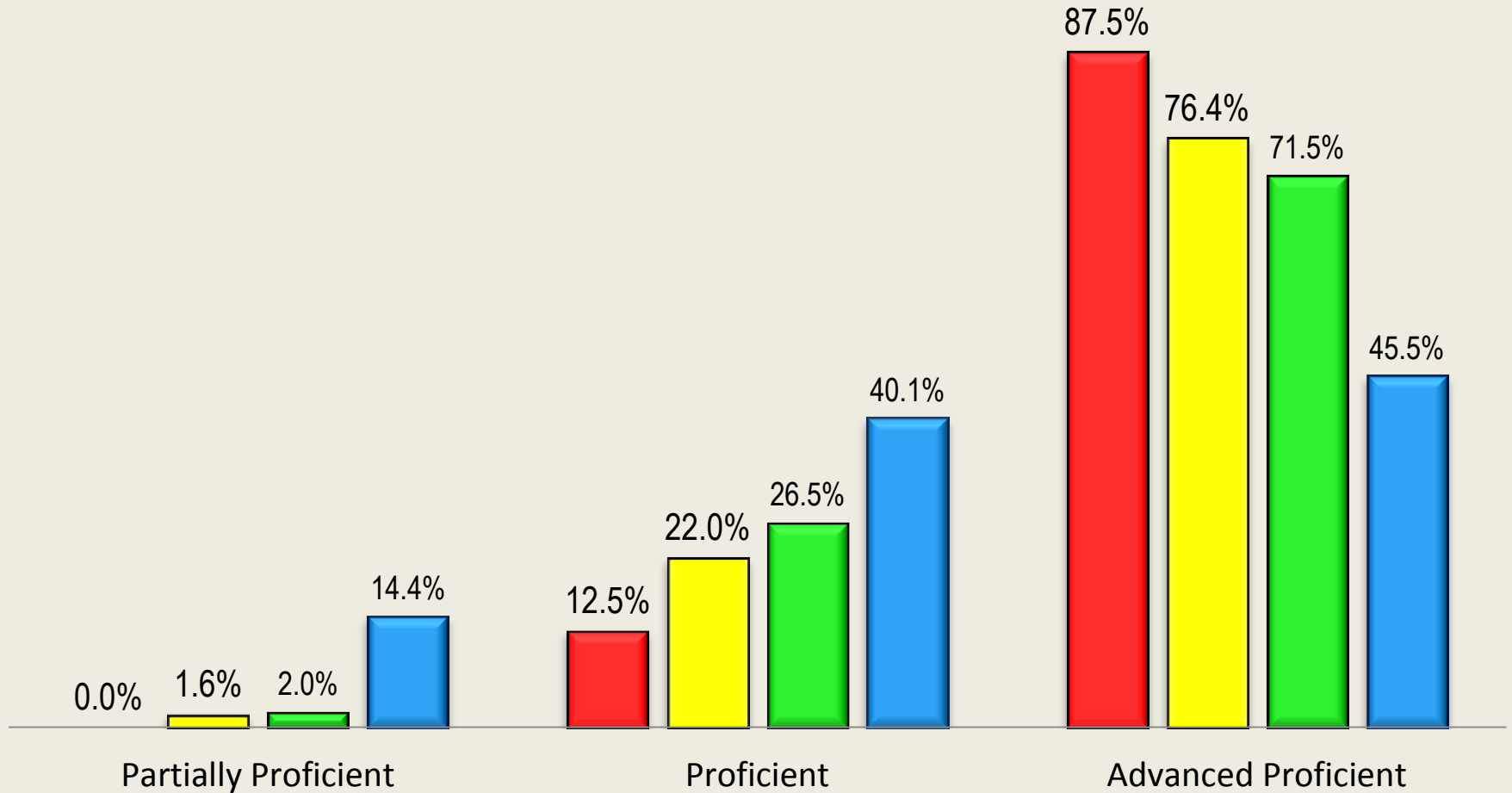

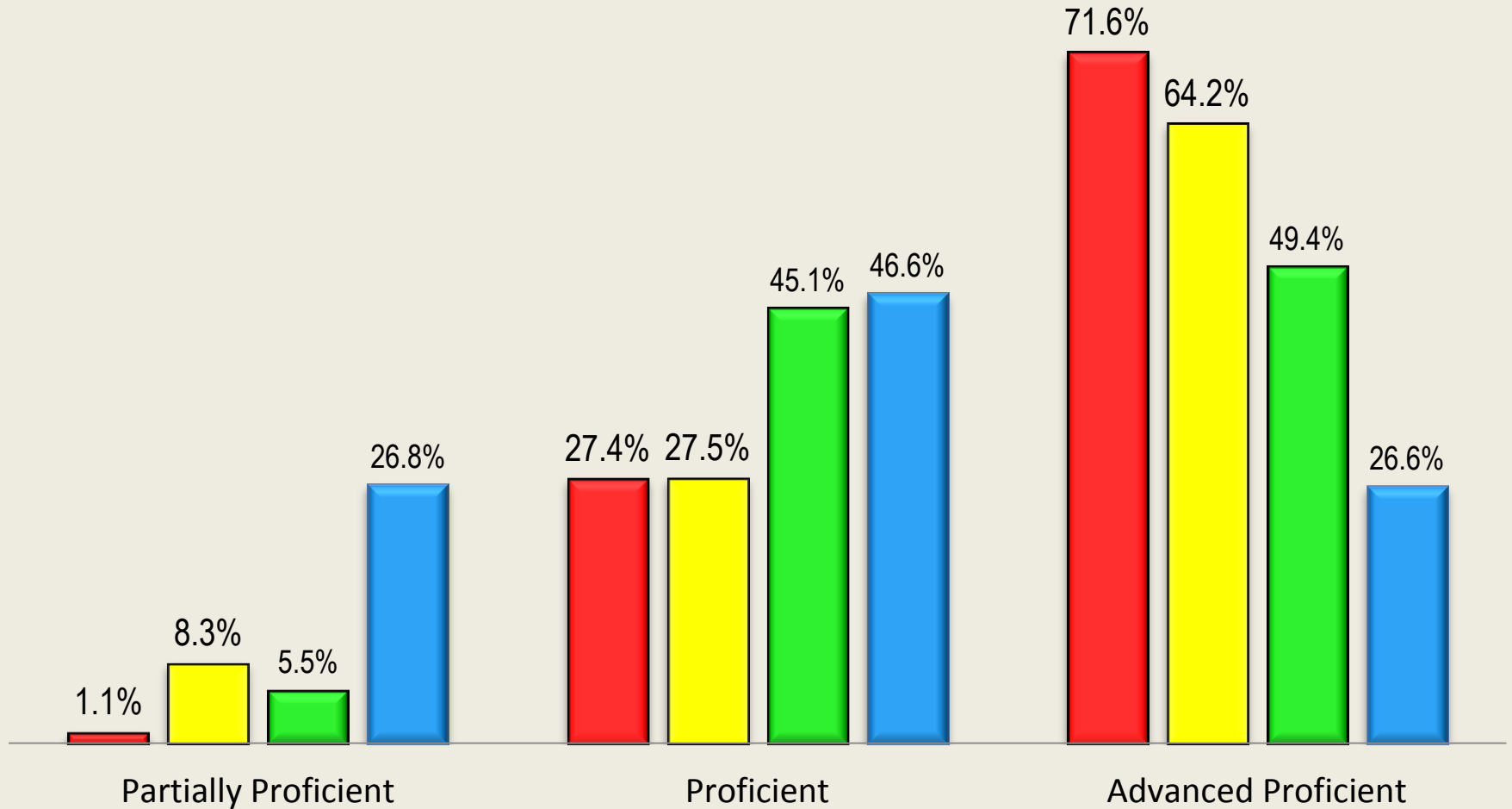
NJASK – Grade 4 Science
